

#### INSPECT YOUR NEW PRODUCT

The package should include the following items which should be removed from the packaging and inspected for damages:

### Elite Delta Light 36W Battery Back-Up. - Part number DL36BB

Thank you for purchasing the Elite Delta Light 36W Battery Back-Up (DL36BB), manufactured to the highest standards drawing upon over 20 years' experience supplying the UK hire and construction industry, this product will, if used in accordance with these operating instructions, labels affixed to the product and properly maintained, provide you with many years of reliable service.

#### PRODUCT USAGE

The  $DL_{36BB}$  is a portable 36-watt LED work light designed for use on the work site, in workshops, garages or other temporary lighting applications. The  $DL_{36BB}$  is supplied in 110V 16A IEC60309 plug and socket formats for temporary industrial applications.

### MAIN CONSTRUCTION

Semi-transparent diffusor manufactured from impact resistant PC providing glare free comfortable use and durability. Long life SMD LED strips for reduced power consumption and minimal heat – easy to handle and quick to store after use. Power cable manufactured from heavy duty VDE rubber cable and industrial IEC60309 plug and panel socket arrangement.

#### GENERAL SAFETY INFORMATION

Ensure power supply is correct frequency and voltage for the Delta Light DL36BB by checking the rating label affixed to the product and confirming with the supply voltage.

Prior to installation carry out the necessary risk assessment considering the people who could be at risk and the precautions required to control the risk.

Never use an electrical appliance in the rain, in wet areas or with wet hands, using an electrical appliance under these conditions greatly increases the possibility of electric shock.

Check the total load on the circuit including the luminaire does not exceed the rating of the circuit cable, fuse or circuit breaker. This includes any appliance connected to the panel outlet sockets.

Ensure that the circuit supply is isolated either by the circuit supply fuse being removed or the applicable circuit breaker being turned off before installation or any maintenance.

If any parts of the Delta Light 36W Battery Back-Up are damaged, do not use and remove from service immediately until corrected if possible. Any part that is damaged, including the casing, cable, or plug, should

be repaired or replaced by a qualified electrician or a trained competent person before the product is used, ensure the product is tested for safety before being reintroduced for service.

Protect cable from contact with sharp objects, chemicals or hot surfaces. Ensure the cable does not cause a

potential trip hazard to user/s or any other personnel working or passing within the operating area. Do not run cables across walkway. Once cables have been safely routed secure in position.

Please ensure that you read these instructions before using the product, and that all the safety guidelines are understood. Please keep these instructions for future reference.

### CAUTIO

**Ensure** power supply is switched off before connecting the Delta Light to the power supply.

Do Not move, reposition or install whilst connected to the power supply and switched on.

Do Not remove the plug from the power supply socket by pulling the cable.

#### Do Not look directly into the light source.

This Elite Delta Light is designed to be used from a 110V power supply only.

This Elite Delta Light should be positioned in a way that it does not cause an obstruction to personnel or machinery.

Ensure the Delta Light is switched off when left unattended, this is both good safety practice and saves energy.

DL<sub>36BB</sub> must not be modified in anyway. Alterations of any description may invalidate the product warranty and

 $DL_{36BB}$  must only be used for its intended purpose. Ensure you are aware of all the safety requirements and the product is suitable for the task you wish to undertake.

Never use  $\text{DL}_{36\text{BB}}$  if you are ill, feeling tired, or under the influence of alcohol or drugs

This DL<sub>36BB</sub> is **NOT** for use in potentially explosive atmospheres.

Do Not use the  $DL_{36BB}$  near flammable gases or liquids.

Keep DL36BB dry wherever possible

 $DL_{36}$  should only be used by a competent person who has read and understood this user manual. If in doubt of any of the instructions, please refer to the reseller or the manufacturer.

Do Not use the DL36BB near a heat source.

Do Not use the Delta Light DL<sub>36BB</sub> if any part of the power cord is or appears to be damaged.

**Keep** children and untrained personnel away from the work area, all visitors should be kept at a safe distance from the work area.

#### INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

This Delta Light DL<sub>36BB</sub> is designed to be used from a 110V power supply only.

Check the total load on the circuit including the luminaire does not exceed the rating of the circuit cable, fuse or circuit breaker. The power supply of this Delta Light is shown on the external packaging and the rating plate on the product. The rating plate can be found on the base section of the product. Check power supply requirements

Connecting the Delta Light  $DL_{36BB}$  to the power supply must be done with care. Ensure both your hands and product is dry. Ensure no personnel are in contact with the  $DL_{36BB}$  when first switched on.

Do Not remove the plug from the power supply socket by pulling the cable.

Do Not connect to the power supply and switch on when the mains cable is coiled up.

The DL<sub>36BB</sub> also features power outlets that can be used to link up to 15 Delta Lights together from a suitable single power source or as a convenient power source for use with a power tool. Please note the total load applied should not exceed the following:

Maximum power outlet load 1500W. Note this is the total power including both sockets.

Ensure a suitability rated power supply is used and consider all other power consumptions within the circuit before applying loads to the outlets.

# INSTALLATION INSTRUCTION

If an extension lead/reel is required in order to reach the mains supply, ensure the cable/reel is uncoiled/unwound and is of the correct specification to carry the load applied. Note excessive lengths of cable may cause issues relating to voltage drops and increased resistance leading to higher currents. If in doubt of the installation consult a qualified electrician.

Do not use in or near places such as swimming pools, ponds, sauna's, bathroom's, shower rooms or similar locations.

Do not install the Delta Light where it is likely to be knocked or cause an obstruction.

If the Delta Light is to be used in a place of work or public space ensure all applicable regulations and laws are adhered to.

# IN USE INSTRUCTIONS

Check for damaged parts! It is recommended a thorough inspect is conducted before every use, if any part is identified as damaged do not use and remove from service immediately until corrected if possible. Refer all servicing of electrical parts to a qualified electrician or a trained competent person. Failure to do so will invalidate your warranty and tested safety standards and may cause injury or property damage.

### ODEDATION

Upon initial connection of the power (110V) to the Delta Light DL<sub>36BB</sub> Battery Back-Up LED indicator will illuminate red to indicate the battery is charging.

Switch the main on/off power switch, to the on position and the main LED light tube will illuminate. Note the Battery Back-Up LED indicator will remain illuminated red to denote the battery is still charging.

Once the battery is fully charged, approximately 6-7 hrs to fully charge from empty, the Battery Back-Up LED indicator will change to green in colour.

If the light is switched off using the main on/off switch the main LED tube switches off and the plug can be removed and the light stored or moved. Note the battery does not operate and the charge level will remain at the level at which the unit was switched off.

note the battery will discharge overtime if even if not used and this may vary dependent upon temperature.
 Typically this may take many weeks to make a noticeable effect on the battery capacity.



### OPERATION - con

In the event the power supply to the Delta Light is disconnected whilst switched on and in use the Delta Light Battery will activate. The charge status LED will switch off and the main LED light tube will illuminate at approximately 30% (1200lm)

To switch the main LED tube off whilst in battery back-up is operational simply press the Battery Back-Up function switch, red button located above the charge status LED. Note once this has been depressed the light cannot be switched back on until the power is restored and the system is reset.

# MAINTENANCE

 $\label{eq:Adaily check is recommended to inspect for any physical damage or abrasions to the cable. \\$ 

All repairs should only be carried out by qualified service personnel or a competent person. Do not open exterior casing of the light head, as there are no user serviceable parts inside. Opening or visible attempts to open or repair a light may void any guarantee and may cause damage to the product or cause personal injury.

If the external flexible cable or cord of the luminaire is damaged, it shall be exclusively replaced by the manufacturer or his service agent or a similar qualified person to avoid potential hazard.

Do not attempt to alter the product as this will invalidate the product guarantee and invalidate safety approvals.

Only genuine Elite spare parts should be used.

If you have a problem with your unit please return it to the outlet from where you purchased it, ensuring that you have full details of your product as described on the product rating label. Should it be necessary for repairs to be undertaken, it is important to provide suitable qualified repair agent with the complete unit. Should you require service under the terms or our gurantee you will need to present proof of purchase prior to works being undertaken.

# CLEANING

Always switch off and disconnect the power supply before any routine maintenance or cleaning.

Do not use abrasive cleaners or polishes as these may damage the surface and reduce optical performance. Clean with a soft lightly damp cloth with a mild detergent. DO NOT immerse or submerge any part of the Elite Delta Light  $DL_{36BB}$  in water or cleaning solution.

Never use solvents or cleaning agents containing petroleum (petrol, kerosene, oil), paint thinner, turpentine, alcohol, or ammonia. Harsh chemicals such as these can damage surfaces.

#### STORAGE When not in

When not in use store in a dry environment.

Ensure the product is thoroughly cooled before handling and storage. Where possible retain and use the original packaging for prolonged periods of storage, conduct a thorough inspection and test after prolonged storage to ensure safe and correct operation.





The Elite Delta Light contains sensitive electronics to operate the LEDs. It is therefore recommended not to conduct Flash Testing or Hi Pot Testing during periodic portable appliance testing as stated within the Code of Practice for in-service inspection and testing of electrical equipment, commonly recommended to the Pot Testing of the Pot Testing of

We would recommend either a reduced voltage insulation test or protective conductor/touch current measurement test to prevent damage and premature product failure.

Failure to comply with our testing recommendations will invalidate the product warranty.




# Recycling


